Jennifer was employed by the Wilson County Transportation Department.

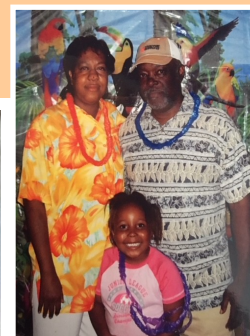

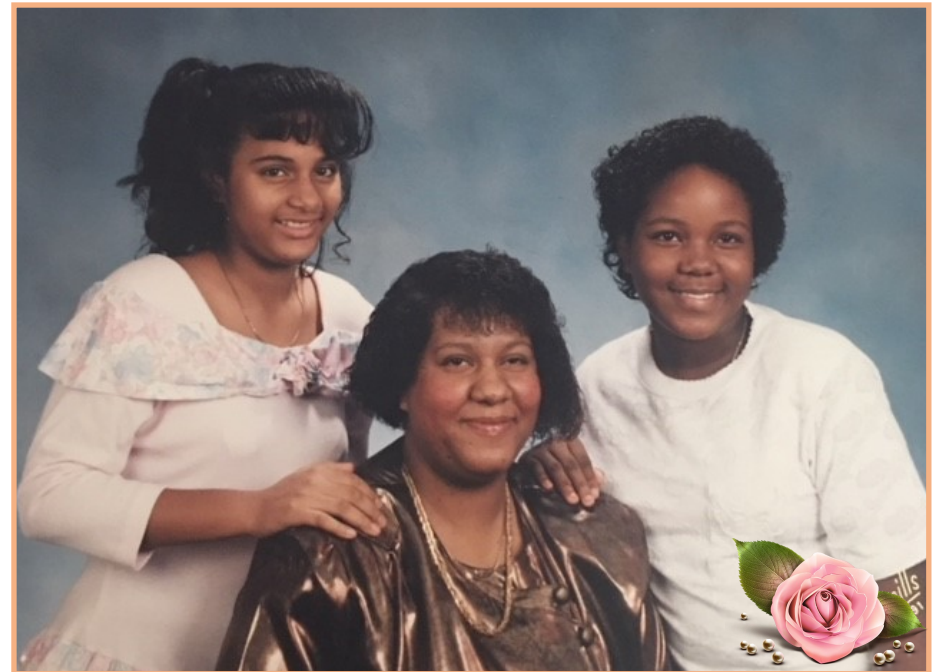
