January 13, 1992 - March 9, 2020



Marque Vernal Sweeting was born January 13, 1992, to Elder Vernal and Mrs. Danette Sweeting. Marque claimed victory on March 9, 2020.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Bishop Samuel Sweeting and Mother Ruth Sweeting, Aunt Pamela Kimbro and Uncle Wayne Williams.

Marque was the youngest of their three sons. He was educated through the Metro-Davidson County Public School System and graduated in 2010. Marque also attended and graduated from Fortis Technical Career College specializing in their HVAC program. He was employed at Good Shepherd Senior Service, where he worked for his father. He had a special bond with his mother, Danette Sweeting, who kept those long dreadlocks looking good.

Since he began to wear dreads, Marque's mother was his only hair stylist...period! Marque loved his two older brothers, Maurice and Marcus; each one knew that they could depend on the other in times of need. Marque was a fierce defender of his younger cousins, especially the girls. He would often say to them, "Let me see him!"

Marque faced challenges from the beginning of his life being born with sickle cell disease. This affliction caused great pain and he often was hospitalized due to pain crisis. Although he had this condition, he pressed forward with a zeal for life. Like many PK'S, Marque often expressed his love for the Lord, came to the altar, received prayer and placed his faith in God's hands. He was a respectful, loyal son and a loving brother.

Marque once ask his father, Dr. Sweeting, "Can God get the glory out of me without my being perfect?" Dr. Sweeting replied, "He's already getting it son -- just trust God." Marque was so proud of the birth of his daughter, Erynn who melted his heart like butter. He knew how to be a friend and how to keep them. If you were his friend, then you became part of the Sweeting family because Marque made you feel welcome no matter who you were. He was a leader in his own right. Marque Vernal Sweeting will be deeply missed.




A BRIGHT NEW WORLD




