## Judy Rena Bell

FEBRUARY 1, 1954 - JULY 21, 2020



Judy Rena Bell was born February 1, 1954 in Chicago, Illinois to Mary Brunson. She was the eighth child of nine. Judy attended DuSable High School in Chicago, Illinois.

Judy gave birth to two sons: Aki Bell and Lawrence Bell. She worked for a number of years in Chicago and in 1986 decided to move her children to Pasadena, California to start anew.

Judy accepted Christ and was baptized in 1987 under the leadership of Pastor George Gamble at New Covenant Christian Church. She joined the choir and was a devoted usher at Prosperity Missionary Baptist Church in Auburntown, TN. In

1988 Judy worked at Broadway in Pasadena Mall in the cosmetic department applying Fashion Fair make-up. She was blessed with the career she wanted and loved. She became a professional make-up artist when asked to work for the Soul Train Award, BET Awards and weddings. In 1996 Broadway closed their doors and Judy felt it was time to visit her mother and sister in Detroit, Michigan. Leaving Detroit she moved to Tennessee where she worked at Dillard's in Murfreesboro, TN applying Fashion Fair make-up until her illness.
