Jacqueline (Quilla) Hurd Harris entered time on July 31, 1934. She transitioned on Thursday September 5, 2013. Jacqueline was the eldest of four children born to Betty Wade Hurd McCadden and the late Everette Theodore Hurd.

At a very young age, she accepted Christ and was a very active church member and a faithful servant at Peyton Road Church of Christ until her passing. Jackie (Quilla) graduated from Wilson County Training High in 1952. She attended Tennessee State University where she studied Nursing from 1990 -1992.
